



- **DOD Deployed Forces Commander (DDMS)**
- **DOD Contingency Response Force** (fire/crash/rescue)
- **C-130 theater airlift**
 - SAR/MEDEVAC, airlift, astronaut crew return
 - 9 PJs, 3 Zodiac boats & 2 MA-2 raft kits per C-130
- **C-21 from USAFE**
 - Astronaut weather reconnaissance flights
 - Landing aid checks
- **Medical support**
 - Two flight surgeons/physicians per TAL
 - PJs/med techs, equipment, blood supply, astronaut medical records
- **Weather support**
 - Forecasters/observers
 - Upper air weather balloon system (Radio Automatic Theodolite System)

Pararescue TAL Support Relocation

- New Facility - Ramstein AB, Germany
 - NASA / DDMS took possession 1 Oct 99
 - Equipment move with STS-103 redeployment from TALs
 - Balance of equipment trucked to Ramstein before STS-99
- STS-103
 - Last Pararescue TAL support from NS Rota, Spain
- Subsequent STS Missions--Consolidation
 - All airlift, medical and Pararescue TAL support originates from Ramstein AB
